



Following the seminar "Interreligious and scriptural studying in Jerusalem" ("Interreligiöses und biblisches Lernen in Jerusalem") in the summer term of 2023, which provides an introduction to the teaching content as well as preparation for the trip, the summer-school takes place during the non-lecture period (September 2023).

The program includes 11 days in Jerusalem with excursions, a variety of local activities, and a two-day stay in Galilee (Tiberias).

The content of the summer-school focuses on Biblical studies and religious education, interreligious dialogue, political education and prevention of anti-Semitism.

Prior to the trip, presentations will be distributed for students to present on site. The destinations of the excursion are:

- Israel Museum with Michael Segal, Professor of Biblical Studies
- Yad Vashem
- Dead Sea with Masada, Jericho, Qumran
- Day trip to Tel Aviv with a visit to the German Embassy
- Drive to Nazareth with sightseeing
- Sea of Galilee
- Visit to an excavation site in Tiberias



Both the preparatory seminar and the excursion can be counted as course credits.

The number of participants is limited. A personal contribution of approx. 1000€ is to be expected.
